



# NOTICE FOR SPACE-A TRAVELERS



To be eligible for the Roll Call process you must adhere to the following:

- ❖ Be signed up for Space-A
  - ❖ Have all luggage on-hand
  - ❖ Payment (CARD ONLY) if required when traveling outside of Japan
  - ❖ All Passengers in a group must be physically present
  - ❖ Documentation required for entry into destination country per the Foreign Clearance Guide: <https://apacs.milcloud.mil/apacs/login.jsp>
  - ❖ ID cards and/or tourist passports (Expired credentials will not be accepted)
  - ❖ Marked Present at the Service Counter no later than 30 minutes prior to Roll Call
- Failure to adhere to the above guidance will result in removal from the selection process.**

# TRAVELERS TO THE UNITED STATES



## **US Military:**

US military personnel on leave require military ID cards and travel orders that indicate active-duty and leave status. Leave orders and military ID cards are considered Western Hemisphere Travel Initiative (WHTI) compliant documents. Passport not required. Visa not required.

## **US Civilians:**

Civilians require a valid (non-expired) tourist passport. Official (No-Fee) passports are NOT an acceptable form of leisure identification. Also, expired IDs or passports will not be accepted.

## **Non-US Citizens and Dual Nationals with Non-US Passports:**

Passport and visa requirements may vary for non-US citizens and for dual nationals traveling on non-US passports. Such travelers should check with the nearest host nation embassy or consulate to determine what credentials are required for entry.

# TRAVELERS WITHIN JAPAN



As of 6 July 2023, DOD personnel must have a **valid (current and not expired)** "regular (blue tourist) passport" to enter Japan while on leave (or other unofficial travel status) per DOD foreign clearance guide section 1.B.1. However, us military personnel on leave returning to their unit of assignment in Japan may travel on military id card and travel orders." Regular (blue tourist) passports are still required for civilian personnel returning to Japan. Tourist passports are recommended while flying within Japan, but a DOD ID will suffice.

# TRAVELERS TO SOUTH KOREA



1. Military personnel on leave require military ID cards and valid leave authorization.
2. Civilian personnel - Regular (blue tourist) Passport required.
3. Visa not required for tourist stays of less than 90 days. A visa is required for tourist stays of 90 days or more.
  - (1) Obtain a visa before traveling to ROK.
  - (2) Tourist visas are valid for one entry within six months of issue for a 90 day stay. Visas cannot be extended, and their status cannot be altered.
  - (3) Personnel staying in ROK for longer than 90 days must apply for an Alien Registration Card.
4. Travelers may obtain the latest visa information and entry requirements at the embassy of the Republic located at 2450 Massachusetts Avenue, NW, Washington DC 20008, Phone: 202- 939-5600, fax: 202-797-0595 or visit the website.
5. Third-country nationals - Check passport requirements for country of citizenship and passport/visa requirements of ROK.

# TRAVELERS TO THE PHILIPPINES



**1. Personnel on leave (including emergency leave) status do not have legal protection under the Visiting Forces Agreement.**

2. Regular (blue tourist) Passports required regardless of nationality.

3. US citizens may enter the Philippines for purposes of tourism without a visa if they present their valid, unexpired US passport and a return ticket to the United States or an onward ticket to another country. It is the travelers' responsibility to maintain the validity of their US passport while traveling in the Philippines.
